Guidelines for preventing and managing COVID-19 at Rybners

How to behave at Rybners to assist in the prevention and management of COVID-19.

Corona passport

All employees, students, and visitors should be able to present a valid Corona passport. If you are not capable of presenting a valid Corona passport, you are not allowed to meet in person at school and your absence will be registered. In the worst case, this could mean suspension.

The school is obliged to control that all students fulfil the requirements of a valid corona passport. You should download the app "Coronapas" onto your smartphone. Every morning, in the first lesson, you should open your corona passport in the app and place the phone in a visible position for the teacher to control the corona passport. If you do not have a smartphone, bring a print-out of your documentation with you.

Notice that according to the penal code §171 about forgery, it is punishable to change, copy, convert or manipulate the corona passport.

Face mask/face shield

Students, visitors, and employees must wear a face mask or a face shield at school. If this requirement is not followed, it can result in suspension.

There are though, some exceptions, where the requirements do not apply:

- When you participate in classes in classrooms or workshops and at exams.
- Teachers who undertake teaching duties, educational activities or exams in classrooms or workshops. The school encourages teachers to use a face mask or a face shield in situations where "proper distance" to students is not possible.
- For people who are exempted from wearing face masks.

CONTACT REDUCTION INITIATIVES

We are following the recommendations of the authorities regarding sectioning and contact reduction at youth and adult education institutions and we have decided to implement the recommendations as follows:

Organising classes

The lessons should be organised in such a way that you mix with students from other classes as little as possible to the extent that it is compatible with the completion of the education according to the current curricular.

We will continue to offer classes in elective subjects and mixed classes. However, you will be placed in groups of students from your own class with as much distance as possible from students from other classes.

Other kinds of activities, normally attended by mixed classes, will be cancelled, e.g. assembly, eSport, club activities etc. Social activities may continue if confined to the home room/form room of the regular class.

Breaks

During breaks you should stay in your own classroom or stay outside where you are requested not to mix with students from other classes.

Food and beverage

The school canteens are open with a limited selection and your class will be given a time where you can buy your lunch. You must eat your food in your own classroom. This is to prevent that too many people are gathered across classes.



INFECTION PREVENTION

At Rybners we follow the recommendations of infection prevention from the Danish Health Authorities. These are:

- Get vaccinated
- Stay home and have a test if you develop symptoms – this is also applicable even if you are vaccinated
- Wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer
- Keep your distance, when possible
- Let in fresh air and open doors and windows once every hour
- Clean and disinfect often, especially surfaces that are touched by many people

Please note that, although we are exempt from the general recommendations for distance in educational situations, in order to minimize the risk of further spread of infection, we still do recommend that everybody keeps their distance where it is possible.

Remember to clean up and disinfect after yourself when using the common areas at school during lessons. Sanitizer and cloths will be available.

Stay home in the following situations

- If you have symptoms of COVID-19
- If you are infected with COVID-19 – remember to inform the school
- If you are a close contact to an infected person – if you have received the third vaccination or have been infected with COVID-19 within the last 12 weeks you can avoid self-isolation provided that you do not have symptoms. You should still be tested according to the recommendations from the Danish Health Authorities.
- If you are a close contact to an infected person and you are not capable of keeping distance to the infected - this is applicable even if you have received your third vaccination or have been infected with COVID-19 within the last 12 weeks
- If you have travelled unnecessarily to one of the countries the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs has advised against visiting

Close contact or other contact to an infected person

If you are a close contact to an infected person you are advised to follow the recommendations from the Danish Health Authorities with respect to isolation and testing. Read more about this in the following link:

Request for two tests a week

The authorities are requesting testing twice a week for students and employees at all youth and adult education institutions. The request is aimed at everyone, which also means people who are vaccinated. If it is less than 12 weeks since you were tested positive for COVID-19, you do not have to be tested. This is due to the fact that you will test positive during this period of time, even though you are well and no longer infect others.

Absence

Even though corona is considered a critical illness to society, the school will not offer emergency lessons for students who are absent due to corona. If you are absent due to infection, have symptoms or are a close contact to an infected person, you will be registered absent like in any other situation and you should register the reason for your absence electronically as always. We advise you to keep yourself informed about lessons in Ludus, Moodle or through your classmates.

Other precautions

- Avoid as far as possible, sharing your tablet, computer mouse, keyboard, tools and other equipment
- Wash your hands before and after use of borrowed equipment. Clean the equipment several times throughout the day and in between use.

INFECTION WITH COVID-19

If you test positive, regardless if you have symptoms or not, you must:

- Immediately self-isolate (no matter which test you have used)
- Inform the school (see appendix)
- Track down and inform close contacts and other contacts and make sure they follow the recommendations from the Danish Health Authorities according to isolation and testing. The school will help by tracking and inform possible infected persons at school. If you have tested positive via a COVID-19 self-test kit, you should not inform contacts until you have

received your positive test from a PCR-test.

- If you have tested positive with a PCR-test or a quick-test, you will receive a letter in your e-Boks from the Danish Patient Safety Authority. You will be requested to share your positive status in the app "Smittestop". You will be anonymous in the app.
- If you have taken a quick-test or a self-test which is positive, you must as quickly as possible get a PCR-test that will show whether the quick-test or the self-test has shown the correct answer. Until you get a negative answer from the PCR-test, you must consider yourself as infected and self-isolate and inform the school (see appendix).
- Stay home and follow the guidelines from the Danish Patient Safety Authority
- If you are symptom free, you may not go to school in person until seven days after your positive test result. If you have had symptoms, you must wait until 48 hours after the symptoms have stopped, before attending school in person again. It is acceptable with mild symptoms, but you are not allowed to take any fever reducing medicaments, such as Paracetamol.
- We request that you keep yourself informed about lessons in Ludus, Moodle or through your classmates
- It is required to show a valid corona passport when meeting at school. The corona passport is not valid until 14 days after a positive PCR-test. If you are allowed to meet before the 14 days, you must contact the nearest leader in your department for clarification.
- Be especially aware of hygiene and cleaning.

Appendix

Procedures for students' communication with the school due to COVID 19

It is very important that you inform the school if you can not attend school due to one of the following reasons:

- If you are infected with COVID-19
- If you have COVID-19 symptoms
- If you are awaiting a COVID-19 test answer and you have symptoms
- If you are a close contact to an infected person. You can stop your self-isolation after a negative test answer from a PCR-test on the fourth day. If you have received the third vaccination or have had COVID-19 within the last 12 weeks, you can avoid self-isolation. You must still follow the recommendations about tests from the Danish Patient Safety Authority.
- If you have travelled unnecessarily to one of the countries the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs has advised against visiting

In case of these incidents, you must immediately inform the school:

STUDENTS AT THE GYMNASIUM – STX, HHX, HTX OG HF

If you are staying at home or go home due because of COVID-19 symptoms, are infected with COVID-19 or are a close contact, you must immediately inform your team teacher/class teacher AND write a note about the reason for your absence in Ludus.

If you are infected with COVID-19, you must also inform the head of your school directly.

STUDENTS AT COMMERCIAL SCHOOL (EUD), EUX OG KURSUS

If you are staying at home or go home due because of COVID-19 symptoms, are infected with COVID-19 or are a close contact, you must immediately inform the school by calling the reception in 79134511.

If you are infected with COVID-19, you must also inform the reception. The reception will pass information on to the head of your school.

If you are staying at home or go home due because of COVID-19 symptoms, are infected with COVID-19 or are a close contact, you must immediately inform Gitte Drewsen on 6120 7616.
